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### Safety and Security - Mechanism

### Mechanism of the Anti-Sexual Harassment Cell

The Internal Complaint Committee is an educational resource as well as a complaint redressal mechanism for the members of faculty, staff and students of the University. Its mandates are:

- To ensure that students, faculty and staff are provided with current and comprehensive materials on sexual harassment
- 6. To promote awareness about sexual harassment through educational initiatives that encourages and fosters a respectful and safe campus environment

The committee seeks to inform the campus community of their right to a respectful work and learning environment. It believes that if we practice respect, exercise empathy in our interactions with others so that we do not hurt anyone through what we say or do, then we can create a campus that is free of sexual harassment.

### Mechanism of the Anti-Ragging Cell


- 1. To meet periodically to discuss and prevent incidences of ragging
- 2. Educate students on the negativity of ragging which will help them to refrain from such acts
- 3. Monitor anti ragging activities in the Institution
- 4. During the assembly and value education class the students are briefed about ragging and ethos of the college
- 5. Anti-ragging billboard is displayed in the entrance of the college
- 6. The whole campus is under CCTV surveillance and the movements of the students are monitored
- 7. Names of those indulging in ragging will be instantly removed from the admission and further action will be taken as per the policy





### Mechanism of the Grievance Redressal Cell

- To accept written grievances from students and staff related to the system.
- To create and implement a mechanism to handle the reported grievances.
- To forward the findings to the Management if necessary for further action.
- To listen, record and scrutinize the grievances submitted to them by the Staff and Students and take necessary steps immediately.
- To attend to the grievances based on the authenticity and gravity of the criticisms made.
- To represent the grievances to the concerned section which may include maintenance, transport, academic, amenities etc.
- 7. To convene periodical meetings to discuss whether the grievances have been settled.
- 8. To make a follow-up of these matters at regular intervals till their final disposal.
- 9. To maintain strict confidentiality, if necessary.




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


